THIS CREDIT IS NOT TRANSFERABLE TO OTHER FACULTIES OR PROGRAMS SHOULD THE STUDENT FAIL TO MEET THE BMOS PROGRESSION/GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS. Students who fail to meet progression/ graduation requirements for BMOS but who meet requirements for another program, may be eligible for transfer to another program at the discretion of the Dean of their Faculty. Students who transfer to another program or fail to meet BMOS Progression Requirements will have the “block credit” that they received as part of the Articulation Agreement removed from their academic record and credit from the Fanshawe Accounting Diploma will be assessed for transfer credit on a course-by-course basis by the Admissions Office. To graduate from the BMOS Program, the following 10.0 courses must be successfully completed at Western.
